It has been instrumental in making the most die-hard red-wine lover change their minds, has won more than 20 awards of its own, been the back-bone of the must-have mixed case special for Summit Club members and most importantly, was the first wine we ever made out of our own fruit at Tertini. Stocks of this wine have now dwindled down to nail-biting levels, and we have taken it off Cellar Door tasting lists. However, the wine can still be enjoyed at selected restaurants while stocks last. Rosé 2010 – Rosé as a brand is enjoying a surge in popularity around the world, especially the dryer styles.

Our Rosé 2010 fits exactly into that category and a short month after its release is fast heading the list of most popular wines out of the Cellar Door.

The colour is light ruby with subtle purple hues. The aroma suggests bright forest fruits while the palate is fresh with berry flavours, crisp acidity and a dry finish.
